## Technical Rider

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### Location

Address: 60 East Balbo Avenue, Chicago, IL 60605

**Cross-streets:** On the North side of Balbo Avenue between South Michigan Avenue and

South Wabash Avenue

Main Entrance: 60 East Balbo Avenue

**Stage Door:** Enter from Balbo Avenue, just west of the building

**Loading Door:** Roll-up Door accessed from the alley to the East of the building. The

alley is accessed by Balbo Ave. or Harrison Ave.

**Parking:** Multi Park is located at 645 S. Wabash at Balbo Avenue directly next to

the theatre. LAZ Parking is located at 1 East 8th St at State St. Discounts

may be available for these lots.

Additional parking garages are located in the area.

Street parking is not available on Balbo Ave and is difficult to find at any

time in the area around the theatre.

**Directions:** All of the directions listed here take you to the main entrance of the

building.

CTA: Harrison – Red Line

Walk to Balbo Avenue, walk East on Balbo Avenue.

Less than a three block walk.

CTA Buses: Many bus lines have stops near the theater. Please consult

### From North Side of Chicago:

Take Lake Shore Drive south to Balbo. Balbo is the first street past Buckingham Fountain.

Turn **RIGHT** at Balbo and proceed three blocks.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

### From Farther North:

Take the Edens (I-94) **EAST** until you come to the I-290/Congress Parkway exit.

Take the exit **EAST** on the Congress Parkway to Michigan Ave.

Turn **RIGHT** (south) on Michigan Ave.

Proceed to Balbo and turn RIGHT.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

#### From Northwest:

Take the Northwest Tollway, (I-90) EAST, until you come to the I-290/Congress Parkway exit.

Continue **EAST** on the Congress Parkway to Michigan Ave.

Turn **RIGHT** (south) on Michigan Ave.

Proceed to Balbo and turn RIGHT.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

#### From the West:

Take I-290 **EAST** until it turns into Congress Parkway.

Continue on Congress until you reach Michigan Ave.

Turn **RIGHT** (south) on Michigan Ave.

Proceed to Balbo and turn RIGHT.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

#### From The Southwest:

Take I-55 **NORTH** to Lake Shore Drive.

Take Lake Shore Drive NORTH until you reach Balbo Avenue.

At Balbo turn **LEFT** and proceed three blocks.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

#### From The South:

Take I-94 **WEST** until you reach the Congress Exit.

Take the exit **EAST** on the Congress Parkway

Continue **EAST** on the Congress Parkway to Michigan Ave.

Turn **RIGHT** (south) on Michigan Ave.

Proceed to Balbo and turn RIGHT.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

#### From Indiana:

Take either I-94 West or the Skyway toward Chicago.

Once in the city, proceed **WEST** until you reach the Congress exit. Continue


**EAST** on the Congress Parkway to Michigan Ave.

Turn **RIGHT** (south) on Michigan Ave.

Proceed to Balbo and turn RIGHT.

The theatre is located on the right-hand (north) side of Balbo.

## **Security and Building Access**

## Security

#### **Front Doors**

During box office hours the front doors of the Merle Reskin Theatre will be open to the public. Access to backstage and offices from the front lobby will not be permitted. Outside of box office hours the front doors will remain locked at all times. The front doors may be used for a limited time only if equipment must be loaded in to a front of house position.

### **Stage Door**

The stage door is located just west of the building. The stage door is locked at all times, to gain access please ring the doorbell. The doorbell is a large green button up and to the right of the stage door.

## **Backstage Guest Policy**

No guests or audience members are permitted backstage, on stage, in the dressing rooms, or offices, prior to, during, or following a performance. Company members are asked to meet their guest a outside the stage door.

#### **Deliveries and Receiving**

All deliveries must be approved by the Technical Director at least 5 business days prior to delivery. No deliveries may be made outside of normal business hours or rented hours without approval by the Technical Director. The renter will pay for labor to receive the delivery.

## **Regulations & Information**

### **Facility & Equipment Availability**

All facilities and equipment are subject to availability. In addition to Rentals, the Merle Reskin Theatre produces a full season of repertory shows for The Theatre School at DePaul University. Equipment is often unavailable depending on the demands of the University. If you are interested in specific equipment please contact the Technical Director.

#### **Smoking**

All DePaul University buildings are smoke free, including the Merle Reskin Theatre. There is no smoking allowed anywhere in the building, including on stage. If anyone is found violating this policy, the renter will be charged a fee for cleaning and sanitizing the affected area. Violating this policy may also result in an early end to the contract, at the discretion of the staff members present.

#### Food & Drink

No food or drink, except bottled water, is allowed onstage or in the dressing rooms. Food and drink may be consumed in the green room.

#### Clean-Up

The Renter must leave any space they use in a clean condition in accordance with the guidelines below. Failure to do so may result in a cleaning fee:

- Remove all items brought in by the Renter
- Dispose of all Trash in receptacle
- Return all items to their original location

Onstage and Backstage areas must be swept, with all added scenery, tape, and equipment removed.

Stage area should be returned to the original condition and configuration as received at the start of the rental.

### **Stage Dimensions**

Fire lane must remain clear. It runs parallel to the plaster line and begins 11'5" from the downstage center edge of the apron, and ends approximately 12'5" from that same

point.

Shape: The apron edge is elliptical.

Depth: 11'5" from edge to the plaster line at center stage

#### **Orchestra Pit**

Dimensions

Area: 450 square feet

The Orchestra pit is directly below the apron. The apron lids are removable in 4' wide sections. With the lids in there is 5' 7" clear space. The pit follows the elliptical curve of the stage and is 39' 7" by 12' at its widest points.

### **Traps**

Use of traps will require advanced notice and approval by the Technical Director. The stage is fully trapped. The traps are all 4' long and 2-1/8" thick, but vary in width. Please discuss your needs with the Technical Director.

#### Stage Floor

Black masonite. The Merle Reskin Theatre cannot provide Marley dance floor.

#### Linsesets

Single Purchase Fly System

Locking fly rail on SL at 5<sup>th</sup> floor level, operator cannot see the stage Linesets

Up to 33 linesets depending on availability Most battens are approximately 45' long

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Electrics are 43'10" long (winch automated, keyed switch at stage floor level). Check with Technical Director for max out limit.

Maximum weight varies by lineset

A sample lineset schedule and list an approximate list of capacities is attached in Appendix B. A current lineset schedule is available from the Technical Director

#### **Soft Goods**

Soft goods are subject to availability and may incur additional resource or labor charges. Please contact the Technical Director with your specific needs to ensure availability. There is no standard soft good configuration.

#### Full Stage Goods:

#### Footlight Trough/Cable Trough

There is a lidded footlight trough that exists just upstage of the apron. It can also be used as a cable trough for passing cables across the proscenium.

### Loading In & Out

Loading in and out may take place through the loading door which is accessible through the alley to the east of the building. Use of the loading door and times it is used must be requested from and approved by the Technical Director prior to the Load-in/out dates. Renters should be aware that it is not a private alley and access is limited.

Loading Door Dimensions

Height: 8' 6" Width: 6' 0"

The loading door is 3'3" above stage level and 6" above street level. A ramp is available for use.

Small items may be loaded in through the stage door on the west side of the building. There is no direct vehicle access to this door.

Equipment meant for front of house positions may be loaded in through the front doors per staff approval.

#### **Fire Curtain**

The Merle Reskin Theatre is equipped with a permanent fire curtain. **Nothing** may be placed in a position that may obstruct the fire curtain. Failure to observe this may cancel any contract.

#### **Restrooms**

The only restroom on stage level is inside the star dressing room. There is a single bathroom available on each level.

## **Backstage Information**

Backstage facilities at the Merle Reskin Theatre are spread over five floors and are only accessible by stairs. Their use is subject to availability and approval.

#### **Green Room**

The green room is located one floor below stage level and can be accessed by stairs on stage left and stage right.

Size: 9' w by 24' 8"

Amenities:

2 fixed benches

Microwave

Refrigerator (located in the trap room)

Toilet & Sink

#### **Dressing Rooms**

Dressing rooms contain counter stations, clothes hanging rods, chairs, mirrors, and sinks. A toilet is available on each floor. The star dressing room, on stage level, has shower facilities. All other dressing rooms are accessed by stairs offstage right.

#### Wardrobe Facilities

There is a room offstage right that is available for wardrobe use. There is also a room on the floor below stage level that may be used for wardrobe. The room below the stage level has 2 washing machines, 2 dryers, and an ironing board. Renters must bring their own ironing equipment, soaps, and other supplies.

#### Offices & Connectivity

An Ethernet port may be available for use in the house during rehearsals. The offices on the second floor are private offices and may not be available for use.

### **Event Spaces**

The Merle Reskin Theatre does not currently have any private event spaces besides the theater itself. Private event spaces are available at The Blackstone Hotel and The Hilton Chicago, both of which are adjacent to the theater. Neither hotel has any relationship with the Merle Reskin Theatre. For private event space at a hotel, please contact the hotel directly.

## **Front of House Information**

### **Seating Capacity**

The Merle Reskin Theatre has **1325** fixed seats distributed over three levels.

Orchestra Level: 577 (plus 6 wheelchair positions)

Mezzanine Level: 383 Balcony Level: 365

There is no standing room at the theater.

#### Accessibility

Please note that the Merle Reskin Theatre is not fully ADA compliant. There are 6 wheelchair positions on the main floor and 1 restroom facility on the main floor. There are no elevators, and there is very limited access backstage. A limited number of assisted listening devices are available for use.

#### **House Boxes**

There is a box on both the house left and house right sides of the theater. These boxes are reserved for equipment usage and are not seated. Use of the box space is subject to availability and requires the approval of the Technical Director.

## **Lighting Information**

#### **House Plot**

The Technical Equipment Package includes the use of lighting already in the air. Additional hang/focus will require written permission and incur additional labor costs.

Additional instruments and specials may incur additional labor and equipment rental charges.


